Restoration of Riparian Areas

Bio-engineering workshops

Since 2014, GWAS has been running bio-engineering workshops in the Ghost Watershed to restore riparian areas that have been affected by various land-uses. Bio-engineering employs low cost restoration techniques using locally harvested, native plants such as willows and balsam poplar.

Workshops are led by environmental restoration experts providing an opportunity for volunteers to learn how to undertake effective restoration projects and restore riparian areas in the Ghost Watershed at the same time. It is also a great opportunity to meet new people!

You will work with hand tools to harvest and plant willow and balsam poplar stakes, so you should be physically fit and enjoy spending time outdoors in varying weather conditions.
